

Tolls / Road use charge, goods transport Austria

The Austrian toll system applies to all vehicles of over 3.5t MPW travelling on motorways and high-speed roads (approximately 2000 km of roads). Tolls are collected electronically by means of a small device called a Go-Box fitted by an adhesive strip to the inside of the windscreen. The Go-Box costs € 5 and is available from agents throughout Austria and in the border zone of neighbouring countries. It may also be ordered online from the web site www.go-maut.at Users have the choice of pre-payment or post-payment of the tolls. Checks to ensure the correct use of the system will be carried out by mobile units, at traffic control points, at the main toll plazas and at the border.
